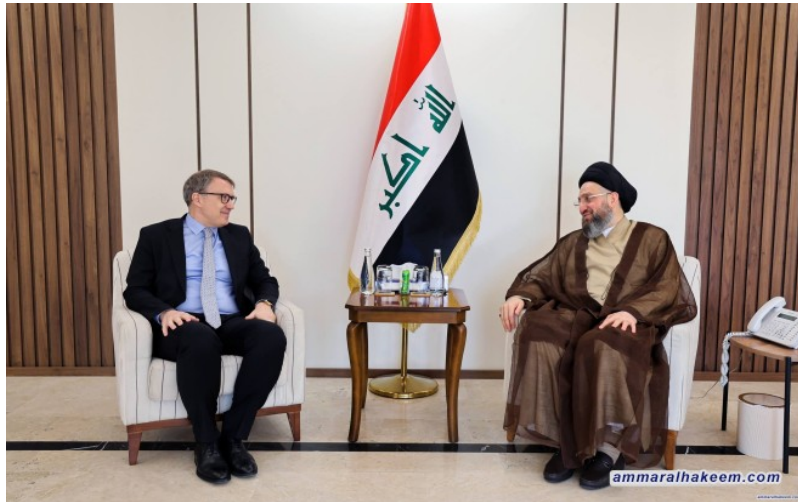


Sayyid Al-Hakeem to Turkish Ambassador: Iraq Experiences Unprecedented Stability, Upcoming Elections Pivotal Toward Sustainable Stability



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, met with H.E. Anıl Bora İnan, Ambassador of the Republic of Turkey to Iraq.
