as part of his ongoing engagement with political blocs and representatives of various components, His Eminence Sayyid Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, received Mr. Mohammed Samaan, Head of the Iraqi Turkmen Front, in his office on Saturday evening, 22 November 2025.
