

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Affirms Adherence to Constitutional Timelines, Programs Over Names to Form Upcoming Government to Al-Jihad And Al-Binaa Delegation



His Eminence Sayyid Al-Hakeem received a delegation from Al-Jihad and Bina' Movement, led by its Secretary-General, Mr. Jawad Al-Saadi, at his office in Baghdad on Sunday, November 23, 2025. The discussions centered on developments within Iraq's political landscape, the outcomes of the latest parliamentary elections, and the positive public awareness they reflected. H.E. underscored the critical need to adhere to constitutional deadlines for appointing the three presidencies and forming the upcoming government.
